Student Parking Permit Rules and Regulations

Student parking on our campus is a privilege. Eligible students' whose applications are approved will purchase a decal for \$35.00 CASH. Replacement for lost decals cost - \$25.00. You must have your decals on display in your car AT ALL TMES. NO EXCEPTIONS or risk having your car towed. In order to promote the safety and security of our school the following Rules and Regulations will apply to student parking at Mandarin High School:

ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Seniors will have first priority for parking. After that, passes may be available for eligible underclassmen.
- ✓ Students must hold a valid driver's license to be eligible for a parking permit.
- ✓ Each vehicle shall be properly registered and insured.
- ✓ Students must be in good academic and behavioral standing.
- ✓ Discipline and/or attendance issues to include tardies, could result in revoking your pass.
- ✓ It is the student's responsibility to supply the school with driver's license and vehicle registration renewal information. Failure to do so could result in suspension of parking privileges.
- ✓ Must have Parental Permission (Signature) on application

RULES:

- ✓ <u>STUDENTS</u> ARE TO PARK IN THE STUDENT PARKING LOT LOCATED IN THE BACK OF THE SCHOOL. THIS YEAR IT'S FIRST COME, FIRST PARK WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE FIRST TWO ROWS IN THE STUDENT PARKING AREA.
- ✓ THE FIRST TWO ROWS IN THE BACK OF THE SCHOOL IS FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE IN THE MR. WILCOX'S LEADERSHIP CLASS. DO NOT PARK IN THOSE TWO ROW UNLESS YOU ARE A LEADERSHIP STUDENT.
- ✓ STUDENTS SHOULD PARK IN THE ALLOTED SLOTS WITH THE "NUMBERS IN WHITE" FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR.
- ✓ All vehicles parked on the school grounds must be registered with the school and must display a current year's decal on the driver's window.
- ✓ Student parking is strictly limited to the designated student parking areas.
- ✓ The school is not responsible for the automobile, contents, or accidents occurring on school grounds.
- ✓ Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
- ✓ Campus Speed Limit is **5 miles per hour**. Speeding or any form of reckless driving on school grounds will result in **revoking** your parking pass.
- ✓ Loitering in the parking lot during the school day may result in suspension of your parking pass.
- ✓ Leaving campus without permission may result in the loss of your parking privilege.
- ✓ Transporting other students off campus may result in the loss of your parking pass.
- ✓ Students cannot lend or give their decals to other students for any reason.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS/PROCEDURES:

- ✓ It is the responsibility of the student to submit an updated application and supporting documentation if your vehicle, license, insurance, registration change or are updated.
- ✓ Report lost/stolen parking decals immediately to Mrs. Flynn. You must purchase a replacement decal.
- Parking privileges may be revoked, if a student violates the Student Code of Conduct.

Parking regulations are strictly enforced.

It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Student Code of Conduct Offenses (tardiness, skipping, truancy, driving over the speed limit, etc.) can result in the suspension or <u>revocation</u> of driving privileges. Suspension of driving privileges, towing of vehicles and/or suspension from school may be enforced if violations occur.
